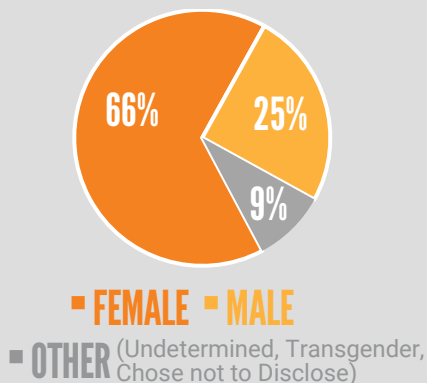
TOP UNMET NEEDS*

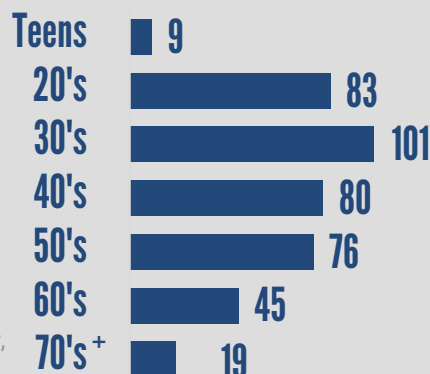

GENDER



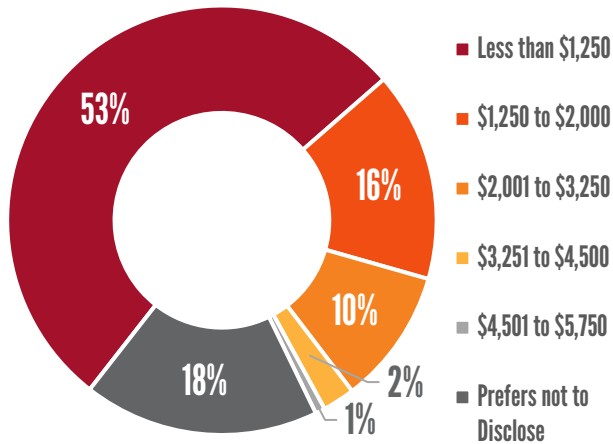

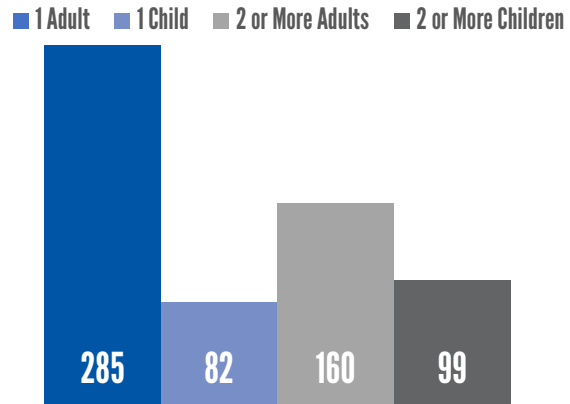
